- o → go – goes ; do – does



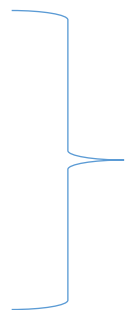

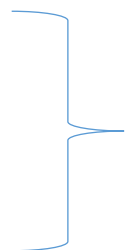

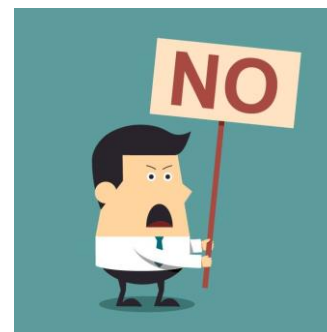
