



PRESENT SIMPLE VS. PRESENT CONTINUOUS



Present Simple

- every day / week / month / year / Saturday / August / summer...
- all the time → ves čas
- When it's sunny / rainy / wet / have time...

- usually → ponavadi
- always → vedno
- sometimes → včasih
- never → nikoli

PAZI!! Usually,
never, always,
sometimes,
never...
postavimo
PRED glagol,
razen **to be** –
takrat stojijo za
glagolom biti.

Present Continuous

- now → zdaj
 - at the moment → ta hip
 - today → danes
 - this morning / afternoon / evening
- I usually go to school by car, but this morning I'm taking the bus. → *izjemoma je danes tako*

More examples:

have

P. S.

P. C.

I **usually** have a sandwich for dinner. I 'm having fish and chips **today**.

It is **sometimes** cold in Autumn.

wear

P. S.

P. C.

He **sometimes** wears jeans and a T-shirt. He 's wearing trousers and a pullover **at the moment**.

- up / 7 o'clock / usually / get / at → He *usually gets up at 7 o'clock*,
- e-mails / often / write → She _____
- not / listen / usually / to the radio → My friend _____
- late / usually / to be → My dad _____
- never / the computer / use → My granddad _____
- always / when I get home / do my homework → I _____
